<p>Bus Monitors/Attendants Qualifications New Monitor/Attendant:</p> <p><i>Within first year must complete SED basic Course 10 hours</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be 19 years of age • Must be approved by the Superintendent in writing • Must have completed 3 hour Pre-service before working with students. • Must have physical performance test prior to working with students. • May be required to have physical, this is up to each school district. • CPR if required by a child's IEP
<p>Bus Monitors/Attendants Qualifications Yearly</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two 2-hr refresher training sessions • Physical no-more than 365 days since last physical (if required by the district) • Superintendents approval • CPR refresher if required
<p>Bus Monitors/Attendants Qualifications Every two years</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Physical performance test
<p>Bus Driver Qualifications New Driver:</p> <p><i>Within First year must Complete SED basic Course 30 hours</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Obtain appropriate license • Check driver abstract and contact previous employer (if driver already) • Fingerprinting • Needs 3 personal references • Superintendents approval in writing • Physical – within 4 weeks of first driving • Physical performance test • Drug test (pre-employment) • SED 3 hr Pre-service completed before transporting students. • Defensive driving review within the first 365 days of hire.
<p>Bus Driver Qualifications Yearly:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two 2-hr refresher training sessions • Physical-no more than 365 days since last physical • Annual Defensive Driving review no more than 365 days after the last one • Minimum of 3 bus safety drills for each route driven • Annual review of driving record • Superintendents Approval • Subject to random, reasonable suspicion and post accident drug and alcohol testing
<p>Bus driver qualifications Every two years:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Biennial Behind the Wheel road test-according to DMV, the first Biennial behind the Wheel test for new drivers must be conducted sometime within the first 730 days of hire. • Biennial Written or Oral Test-according to DMV, the first written/oral test for new drivers must be given within the first 730 days of hire. • Physical performance test
